## Reflections of Life



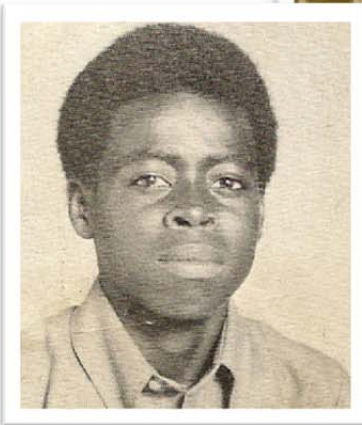
